

Here are some things to know about fair:

At fair, the horse clubs hold a parade into the arena. The clubs are able to have announced information about the club, including their names, activities, and other information about the club.

The club can pick a song that they wish to have played during their entry into the arena. Please make sure that the song and content are 4-H and age appropriate.

The grand entry form is attached so that your club can enter the parade with your chosen song and information.

The clubs have a lot of fun coming up with the 'right song' for their club. As a leader, please remember the appropriateness of the music and lyrics. And please express safety prior, during and after the parade.

As you may know, we depend on the generosity of businesses and individuals to help pay for clinics, prefair, county fair, and other activities.
