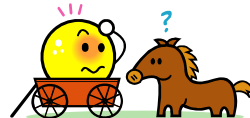

GENERAL RULES

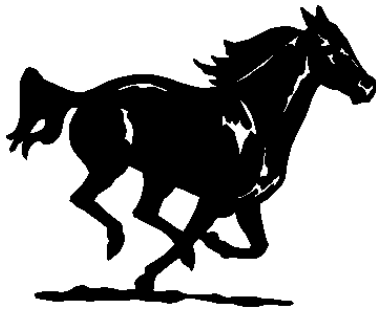
- HELMETS REQUIRED FOR ALL RIDERS 17 & UNDER, RECOMMENDED FOR ALL RIDERS.
- ALL MANAGEMENT DECISIONS ARE FINAL.
- NO REFUND WITHOUT VETERINARIAN DOCUMENTATION.
- Boots, long pants and sleeved shirts are required in all events, no bare midriffs.
- Classes may be split at show committee's discretion. Split classes will be conducted as a work off. Notice will be given.
- Classes may be combined at show committee's discretion. Notice will be given day of the show. Points will be tallied according to original age group.
- Horses that are out of control will be excused from the arena.
- Ages of rider as of January 1st, 2009.
- All riders/handlers under 16 years of age must have adult supervision.
- NO DOGS ALLOWED ON PROPERTY AT ALL.
- ABSOLUTELY NO ALCOHOL BEVERAGES ALLOWED ON PROPERTY AT ALL.
- ABSOLUTELY NO SMOKING ON GROUNDS, EXCEPT IN YOUR VEHICLE.
- Any owner or exhibitor whose personal check fails to clear the bank, has 10 days to make the check good. If he or she fails to do so, points for that show will not count for year-end awards, and will not be able to participate at further events until said check is paid in full. There is a \$25 NSF fee for each NSF check.

OHA No Glamour No Glitz show committee reserves the right to remove contestants from Novice division if their times place them consistently in the top 4 placings of the 13 & Under, 14-17, 18 - 38 and 39 & Over age divisions. Eligible for daily awards; not eligible for year end buckle awards and ROMs'. Special year end awards will be awarded.

13 & Under, 14 - 17, 18 - 38, 39 & Over: Meant for rider, who ride without assistance, to complete patterns and compete with others in their age group. Eligible for daily awards, year end buckle awards and ROMs'.

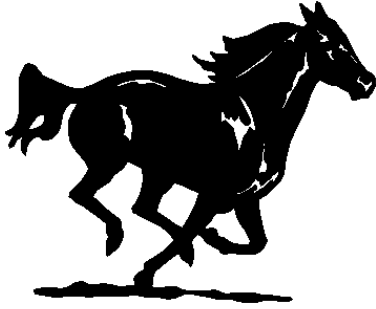
