Saturday classes will include jumping, English pleasure, English equitation and trail will begin at 2pm. Sunday classes include reining at 7am and then continue with halter, showmanship, western pleasure, western equitation and trail starting at 2pm. Sunday also has leadline for those 6 years and under.
